How can we make Salt Creek a SAFER place for ALL?



Do NOT bring toys or dangerous objects to school.

Backpacks should have school supplies and lunch ONLY!





Do NOT take other people's snacks or lunches.



Leave the lunch bins alone.

Do not open or touch other people's lunches.



If you touch or take their food, it can make them sick.



Some kids have allergies to foods or have to follow a special diet.



RESPECT other people's property.



Do NOT touch, kick or move anyone else's backpack, jacket, lunch box, or pencil box.

You would not want anyone to touch your things, so please don't touch theirs.

Do NOT open anyone else's backpack or go into anyone else's desk. You have no right invading their personal property and taking anything from them.



Respect school property.



Respect ALL school property, including bathroom fixtures and soap dispensers.

Vandalism in our bathrooms has cost the school lots of \$\$\$\$ MONEY \$\$\$\$ and TIME to fix.







Do NOT come to the office without permission.

Do NOT come down to the health office or front office without PERMISSION and a slip, note, or behavior referral from an adult.





An adult in the office will make your phone call for you if you are sick, injured, or if you forgot your homework, lunch, or need a change of clothes.

Do not bring all of your friends with you to the office.

Calling someone names is a form of Bullying, DON'T do it!



Calling someone names based on their appearance, their ethnicity, their language, or their interests is NOT O.K.

Racial slurs are NOT tolerated at Salt Creek

We ALL deserve RESPECT.


REPORT unsafe behavior immediately.
